The project was delivered in a live environment with all surrounding buildings to remain operational during construction. To mitigate the risk to public safety caused by limited access to the site, The Taylor team implemented stringent OH&S policies and

procedures. Taylor worked collaboratively with Blacktown City Council to ensure milestones were reached on time, which was an important requirement for Council to receive the necessary Federal Government funding.
