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Dear Francisco,

In relation to your request re Project Echidna - SSD-47320208, and the Aboriginal Cultural Heritage (ACH) SEAR that recommends that an ACHAR be prepared, Heritage NSW provides the following advice. I have reviewed - *Project Echidna Waiver Request, Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Assessment Report (ACHAR), 27 July 2022*, and make the following comments and recommendations.

I note that this memo has considered the potential impacts of the Proposal on Aboriginal cultural heritage values prescribed in the NPW Act and relevant heritage mapping database, including AHIMS and SHI. The Proposal would have no impact on these Aboriginal cultural heritage values.

• How have those values been accessed without undertaking consultation with Aboriginal people and what are those values?

I note that the memo states that - Based on the above Aboriginal heritage search, no known objects or places of Aboriginal heritage significance were identified within the site or immediate surrounds. The site is located within an established industrial area at Eastern Creek. Therefore, it is unlikely that objects or places of Aboriginal heritage significance would be impacted by the Proposal.

• How was the this assessment of significance determined? There was no evidence of even a site survey being undertaken.

In conclusion, the memo states – that in light of the above findings, it is requested that the Proposal be exempt for requiring preparation of an ACHAR.

• There have been no findings presented, as no assessment in relation to cultural values and/or site survey has been undertaken.

Heritage NSW advises that for a limited number of SSD and SSI proposals, a preliminary and/or alternative assessment in relation to ACH may be considered adequate. Heritage NSW requires that a proponent justify this in writing, supported by a suitably qualified person.

An ACHAR may not be required if the proposal involves:

- work on an existing building or structure that does not exceed the current building footprint and does not involve disturbing the ground surface, and/or,
- development of a site where a recent Aboriginal cultural heritage assessment (ACHAR) has identified that
 Aboriginal cultural heritage is not a matter for consideration and Aboriginal community consultation has previously
 occurred according to the Consultation Requirements. This could include:
 - an ACHAR completed in the last five years (e.g. for precinct planning, Growth Centres, or planning proposals) provides evidence that Aboriginal cultural heritage is not a matter for consideration for the site and project
 - where an AHIP has been issued over the proposal area and Aboriginal cultural heritage values have been completely removed or destroyed, or the proposed development is in accordance with the conditions of that AHIP
 - where there is an existing Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Management Plan (ACHMP) for the proposal area, and development is in accordance with the ACHMP.

Based on the information provided, Heritage NSW recommends that the following SEAR is still applicable to this proposal with respect to Aboriginal cultural heritage (ACH).

Aboriginal Cultural Heritage

 Provide an Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Assessment Report (ACHAR), prepared in accordance with relevant guidelines, identifying, describing and assessing any impacts to Aboriginal cultural heritage sites or values associated with the site.
